Florence Nightingale, Robin hood, Three Musketeers.

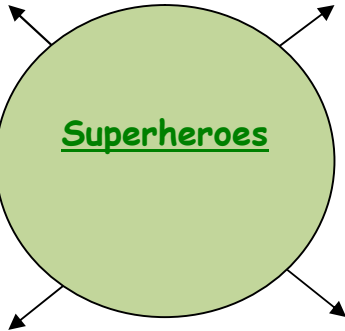
