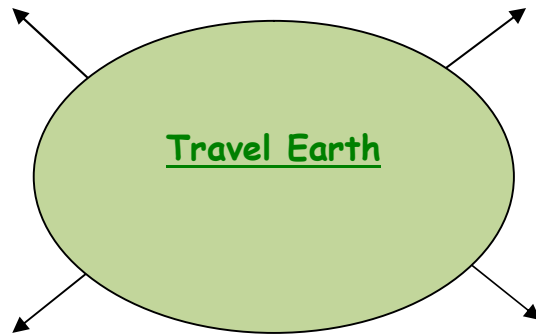

**Outdoor Learning:**
