Locate London and Newcastle / Gateshead on map. Historical maps and compare to present day.

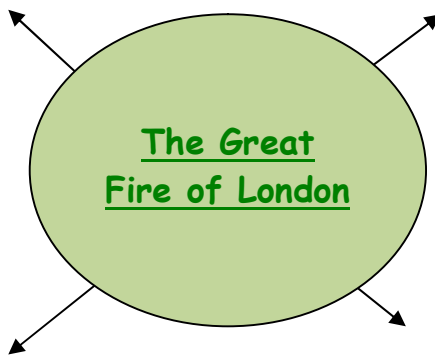

**PSHE / SMSC:**

How could you get out of your house - plan how.

Outdoor representation of the GFL. Demonstrate how fire travels and is blocked.

**Science / Eco:**  
**Animals Humans**  
Notice that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults.  
Describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene. Offspring which grow. Basic needs for survival water, food and air. Exercise food and hygiene.
