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English:
A variety of Reading and Writing genres linked to World War II.

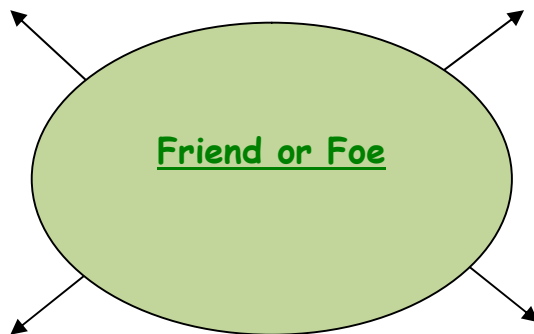
History: WWII continued.
Investigation of life during 1940s wartime. Opportunity for pupils to see first-hand a range of historical artefacts. Evacuation, and rationing.
How did the war end?

Geography:
Identifying significant places and events of WWII on a world map.
Identify where children might have been evacuated to on a map of UK - contrasting locations of city and countryside.

Computing:
Online Safety



PSHE / SMSC:
Evacuation, victims of war past and present, prisoner of war.

Discrimination, prejudice and racism.

Outdoor Learning:
Dig for Victory continued. Maintenance and looking after (feeding, watering) crops.

Fieldwork - record the evacuation journey and note feelings and emotions as the evacuation takes place.

Forest School:
Planting and looking after crops and flower beds.

Science / Eco:

Light
Recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines.
Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.
Explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.
Use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

Art / DT:
Free painting and drawing related to the class novel. Allow for free choice of materials including mixed medias: watercolour, charcoal, paint, collage to support mastery of art and design techniques. Understand how key events and individuals in design and technology have helped shape the world.
Rationing recipes - healthy eating, predominantly savoury foods.
Mother's Day Card.

Music:
Charanga music.
